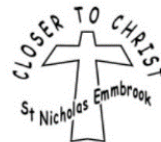

Godspotting

To dwell in the world is to attend fully and properly to the life we have been given. It is to notice the people and themes who keep cropping up in front of us and to reflect on them, to think about them, to pray about them, to experience God in them and in that pattern and gift.

At night, before you turn off the light, take a pen and paper and ask God to guide you. Then think:

- 1) Which conversation has been filled with grace today?
- 2) Which person do I keep thinking back to?
- 3) What is God saying to you?

Write it down for a week and then see at the end of that time whether there is a pattern or sense of course in who you have noticed. And then tell a member of the clergy so we can begin to see what God might be saying to us through our Dwelling in the World.
